COVID-19 Task Force

MIAA Covid-19 Recommendation

Based on the recommendations of the MIAA Sports Medicine Committee (SMC), the MIAA Covid-19 Task Force (CTF) recommends the MIAA Board of Directors approve the changes made to following sport modifications for the Fall II season:

Field Hockey (SMC 22-0, CTF 21-0)

Soccer (SMC 22-0, CTF 21-0)

Volleyball (SMC 22-0, CTF 21-0)*

** Adult supervision of cleaning of the ball and limit to 15 athletes on game day roster*



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MIAA Covid-19 Recommendation

Based on the recommendations of the MIAA Sports Medicine Committee (SMC), the MIAA Covid-19 Task Force (CTF) recommends the MIAA Board of Directors approve the following sport modifications for the following Fall II sports:

Indoor Track and Field (SMC 15-6-1, 20-0 CTF)*

Unified Basketball (SMC 21-0-1, 21-0 CTF)

*Football (SMC 15-5-1, 17-0**CTF)*

** Removed video option for officiating the long jump and shot put*

*** Team box to 10 yard line to enforce social distance requirement*



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MIAA Covid-19 Recommendation

With the addition of the Fall II season, the MIAA Covid-19 Task Force recommends the MIAA Board of Directors communicate a reminder to member schools that a student athlete may only participate in one sport per season.

MIAA Covid-19 Recommendation

Based on the recommendation of the MIAA Tournament Management Committee (17-0), the MIAA Covid-19 Task Force recommends the MIAA Board of Directors support the elimination of MIAA sponsored post season tournaments for the Fall II season.



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MIAA Covid-19 Recommendation

The MIAA Covid-19 Task Force recommends the MIAA Board of Directors encourage schools to create a Fall II season schedule within leagues, or geographic regions to limit travel and number of opponents.



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Spring Sports Approval Process . . .

- Sport Committees present proposed sport specific guidance and modifications in writing to the Sports Medicine by Monday, March 8.
- The Sports Medicine Committee presents viable Spring sports and their modifications to the MIAA Covid-19 Task Force by Wednesday, March 10.
- The MIAA Covid-19 Task Force votes on recommendations for the Spring season on Thursday, March 11.
- MIAA Board of Directors votes on the MIAA Covid-19 Task Force recommendations and notifies MIAA member schools of the approved interscholastic sports and their modification for the Spring season. Friday, March 12 is the suggested meeting date.
