

## **OVERSCHEDULING – EXCLUSION SCHOOLS AND NON-EXCLUSION SCHOOLS**

1 – Any school overscheduling must forfeit the game(s) listed on their ORIGINAL Schedule & Commitment Form. Examples: Field Hockey allowed 18 games and scheduled 19 – would forfeit game 19; Basketball allowed 20 games and have scheduled 22 – would forfeit games 21 & 22.

2 – Schools on the Exclusion list (White Book of Forms – page 6):

- a. May NOT exceed the season scheduling limits for schools
- b. May NOT “No-Count” League contests
- c. If 2 Exclusion Schools play each other, at least 1 school MUST COUNT the contest

3 – If playing an Exclusion School that is part of your league schedule, you MUST count the game – you cannot exclude league contests vs exclusion schools.

4 – A school NOT on the Exclusion list may increase their season schedules up to 2 additional games above the season scheduling limits for schools, providing that the number of additional contests are scheduled against schools on the Exclusion List.

5 – Endowment Games – All schools (Exclusion or Non-Exclusion) may schedule 1 additional Endowment Game (\$300/event) – this game must be agreed to by both schools and must be APPROVED (via MIAA Endowment Game Application) by the MIAA at least 15 days prior to game/event and WILL NOT COUNT for Tournament seeding.
