



2017-2018 MIAA Coach of the Year Nomination Form

“Recognizing Excellence in Character, Achievement and Coaching”

This award seeks to recognize and honor “teacher coaches” who have had an impact on the lives of student-athletes, by encouraging them to succeed and by helping them develop self-confidence, ambition, a sound work ethic, and other skills or values necessary or helpful for success in their later lives. Award candidates should have a record of encouraging student-athletes to be well-rounded (i.e. displaying excellence in areas of scholarship, citizenship, fine arts, etc.), as well as a reputation, among their peers and the athletic community, for fair play, good sportsmanship, and the development of these attributes in their student-athletes.

Criteria for Selection:

1. Must be an **active varsity coach for at least five years in a MIAA sanctioned sport (nomination must be for either Boys or Girls – not both) at a MIAA member school and if selected cannot be nominated again.**
2. Must be recognized as having provided leadership for students on and off the field of play.
3. Shall have a demonstrated appreciation and high expectations for hard work and maximal effort, and be effectively able to transfer this value to his/her student-athletes to help develop self-discipline, sound judgment, and respect.
4. Shall have shown interest in the lives of student-athletes both on and off the field, personally working to encourage sound decision-making in both areas.
5. Shall have a strong appreciation for team success and strict adherence to the rules/regulations during competition, instilling this desire for excellence and commitment to fair play in his/her athletes.
6. Shall have contributed to his/her community at large, outside the realm of athletics. Examples might include:
 - a. Participation in civic and/or service organizations within the community;
 - b. Service as a role model for student-athletes he/she has coached and to students in general.

If you feel that you have a nominee who meets these criteria, please complete and submit the attached MIAA Nomination Form, along with any supporting materials (nomination form must be completed for candidates to be considered). A selection committee of MIAA Coaches’ Education Instructors will determine award recipients who will be honored at the end of the school year. Information on date and venue TBD. All winners selected will also be nominated for the NFHS Section I and National Coach of the Year 2018-2019.
