Participants will learn seven strategies that will lead to high motivation for all students and breaking the cycle of low motivation.

In this program, participants will learn how to effectively use the following seven strategies in their classrooms to maximize student motivation and help their students develop an intrinsic desire to learn:

1. Teacher and student beliefs about the nature of intelligence and its connection to student motivation
2. Growth mindset
3. Connecting the curriculum to the students' lives, prior learning and future learning
4. Teacher enthusiasm
5. Providing teaching that engages the student
6. Differentiating instruction
7. Maximizing the power of interpersonal relationships (teacher to the student and student to student)
