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As educators, we have been given the SEI tool belt. This workshop will take SEI to another level. After learning about Response to Intervention (RTI) and how to build our instructional toolbox, we review SEI strategies available to teachers and administrators and create a system of RTI for our EL students.

Participants will:

- Identify the basics of RTI and Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) as systems to build instruction.
- Review ACCESS information and WIDA materials to build a foundation of instructional strategies.
- Determine SEI instructional strategies and data within the RTI/MTSS systems.
- Build personal systems of RTI for their EL students' foundation of instructional strategies.
