Judy Slamin, of Newton, passed away peacefully on November 3, 2023, with her family by her side.

Judy was the founder of SMASH and served as Administrator of SMASH Volleyball for over 25 years. She was also a High School and College Volleyball Official for 25 years, a Volleyball Chairperson for the Boston Board of Officials, and Past President of the Boston Board of Officials.

She served as MIAA Central Massachusetts Girls and Boys Volleyball Tournament Director, and the MIAA State Boys Tournament Director.

Judy received the following recognitions for her work:

- ◆ Winner of the Judge Franklin Flashner Award from the City of Newton for contributions to the youth of Newton (1982)
- ◆ In 1997 she was inducted into the Northeast Agenda Women's Hall of Fame, in recognition of her outstanding accomplishments and contributions to the development of Women's Athletics
- ◆ In 2014 she was given a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Volleyball Hall of Fame.
- ◆ Awarded the 2018-2019 MIAA Official of the Year for Girls Volleyball
- ◆ 2022 recipient of the MIAA Massachusetts Women in Athletics Distinguished Service Award

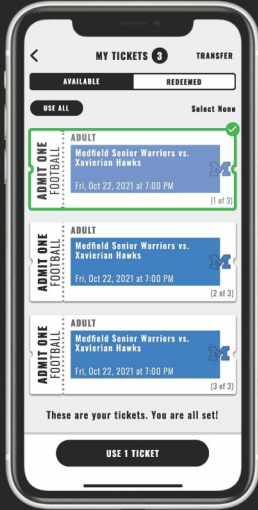
Student Advisory Committee
