Fall 2023 Power Rankings

The first Power Rankings for Fall 2023 sports – Field Hockey, Football, Boys and Girls Soccer, and Girls Volleyball -- will be released and published on the <u>Tournament Central</u> section of the MIAA web site on Friday, September 29.

Athletic directors are asked to make sure their schedules and results are accurate and up to date on Arbiter on a nightly basis throughout the school year. The power rankings and tournament seedings depend on complete and accurate data from all MIAA schools.

Beginning in October, updated power rankings will be published on the MIAA web site every Tuesday and Friday throughout the remainder of the Fall 2023 regular season.

Soccer Infraction Reporting

All varsity soccer infractions (yellow cards and red cards) must be submitted via the online <u>Soccer Infraction</u> <u>Reporting Form</u> following each game. The home school athletic director is required to submit this information. Sub-varsity should not be reported through this online system. Please note – when a red card is issued, the new student/coach disqualification forms referenced in this newsletter must also be emailed to Donna Harrington at <u>dharrington@miaa.net</u>. The MIAA Soccer and Sportsmanship Committee appreciate the assistance and attention to detail of member schools when submitting this required information.

NEW Student and Coach Disqualification Forms

Please make sure that the new <u>MIAA Student Contest</u> <u>Disqualification Form</u> and <u>MIAA Coach Contest</u> <u>Disqualification Form</u> are available at each contest site and discard any previous versions of these forms. When a student or coach is disqualified from a contest, these forms must be completed by the game official and submitted to the athletic director in charge of the contest, or designee, before leaving the site. Please reference <u>MIAA Handbook</u> <u>Rule 49</u> for additional school requirements when a student or coach is disqualified from a contest.

Entries must be submitted as an essay of no more than 500 words or as a public service announcement of 30 or 60 seconds in duration. The theme of this year's contest is "*How can you use social media to positively promote sportsmanship in your school?*" First place (\$400) and Runner-Up (\$200) prizes will be presented in both contest categories at the annual Sportsmanship Summit on November 9.
