Approved MIAA Rule Changes for the 2025-2027 Handbook

The 2025-2027 MIAA Rule Change Proposal process has been completed. In accordance with MIAA Rule 88.2.4, the MIAA Board of Directors convened on January 8, 2025, to review and vote on the proposed rule changes. Of the 26 submitted proposals, 13 were approved.

All approved rule changes will be forwarded to MIAA Legal Counsel for legal review before being incorporated into the handbook, effective July 1, 2025.

Student & Coach Contest Disqualification Forms

Please make sure to use the most up-to-date version of the MIAA Student and Coach Contest Disqualification Forms. The forms are available in the "Officials" section of the MIAA website.

When a student or coach is disqualified from a contest, the required form must be completed by the game official and submitted to the athletic director in charge of the contest before leaving the site. Below are links to each form:

Please note - All fields within the form are required to be completed by the game official with a description of the disqualification **including the violation called.** Forms submitted with incomplete information may be returned to the host school/game official to provide missing information.

Student Eligibility Waiver Deadlines

As a reminder, below is the deadline for student eligibility waiver submissions as outlined in MIAA rule 87.1. This is a firm deadline and late waivers will not be accepted.

Winter 2025 Power Rankings

The first power rankings for winter 2025 sports were released to schools and published on the MIAA web site on Friday, January 10. Updated power rankings will be released each Tuesday and Friday through the remainder of the winter 2025 regular season. Athletic directors are asked to make sure their schedules and results are accurate and up to date on Arbiter on a nightly basis throughout the school year. The power rankings and tournament seedings depend on complete and accurate data from all MIAA schools.

Middle Level and Coop Team Application Deadlines

The spring 2024-25 middle level waiver and cooperative application deadline is April 4, 2025.

Swimming Software - Hy-Tek Team Manager

All Swimming programs must use Hy-Tek Team Manager beginning in the 2024-25 school year. Team Manager Lite *cannot* be used anymore. Basketball Shot Clock Procedure

NFHS Basketball Shot Clock Guidelines state, "An alternate-timing device or procedure shall be available when a visible shot clock malfunctions." In accordance with this rule, the MIAA Board of Directors has approved the following procedure.

If one visible shot clock malfunctions:

Continue play with one visible clock.

If **both** shot clocks malfunction:

- An alternate-timing device must be utilized at the scorer's table.
- Time should be announced at 10 and 5 seconds remaining.
- The shot clock operator should use a horn different from the game clock.

Neck Laceration Protectors for Ice Hockey Required 2024-25

In the spring of 2024, the NFHS Ice Hockey Rules Committee added neck laceration protectors to the required ice hockey equipment. All high school ice hockey players are now required to wear a neck laceration protector – in its original manufactured state and as intended by the manufacturer – during all MIAA interscholastic contests, scrimmages and practices.

Spirit of Sport Award:

- Seeks to recognize those individuals who exemplify the ideals of the positive spirit of sport that represent the core mission of educationbased athletics
- May be given in recognition of a specific act or for an activity of longer duration
- Could be awarded to an individual or group that has demonstrated exemplary sportsmanship and/or citizenship in playing the game as it should be played; has exceeded normal expectations in assisting others within the school or community; or has overcome adversity or a challenging circumstance.

- Seeks to recognize those individuals who exemplify the ideals of the positive hearts of the arts that represent the core mission of educationbased activities

- The recipient could be any student, adult or group associated with the school's performing arts program.
