Position Overview: The MIAA is seeking dedicated and organized individuals to serve as the **Division 1 North, Division 2 North** and/or **Division 3 West** Sectional Golf Tournament Directors for the 2025 fall season. This role involves overseeing all aspects of the golf tournaments, from securing venues to managing day-of operations and ensuring accurate scoring and awards distribution. Athletic directors and coaches are eligible to apply.

Key Responsibilities:

- 1. Secure Golf Course:**
 - Identify and book a suitable golf course for the sectional tournament.
 - Coordinate with golf course management to ensure all logistical needs are met.
- 2. Confirm Accuracy of Seasonal Results:**
 - Review and verify the seasonal results of participating schools and players.
 - Ensure all data is accurate and up-to-date prior to the tournament.
- 3. Tournament On-Site Management:**
 - Be present on-site for the entire duration of the tournament.
 - Oversee all aspects of the event, ensuring smooth operations from start to finish.
- 4. Scoring and Awards:**
 - Manage the scoring process, ensuring accuracy and fairness.
 - Familiarity with the tournament scoring system, Golf Genius.
 - Organize and distribute awards to winners and participants.
- 5. Communication:**
 - Communicate the tournament details with Athletic Directors and Coaches.
 - Work directly with the MIAA Golf Liaison to ensure all guidelines and standards are met.
