Approval of the Spring 2021 Tournament Format is tabled. Will look at format once more is determined regarding the status of the spring seasons.

Given there are no fall tournaments being held, the rotations for hosting the state tournaments will carry over to the Fall, 2021 tournaments.

The realignment proposal originally forwarded to the Tournament Management Committee had to be changed. For consistency, the TMC is requiring that all sports move to four divisions. The realignment sub-committee of D. Keir, M. O'Brien and A. Trytko reconvened and presented a new proposal with schools evenly distributed among four divisions. This proposal will now go to the TMC for approval.

Golf modifications – A. Trytko reviewed the process for establishing the modifications and reported on the virtual town hall information session that was held on September 15.

C. O'Donnell shared an additional document she put together with further detail on all modifications.

Covid 19 Task Force– T. Holgate, a member of the task force, indicated the group is in a bit of a holding pattern at this time and waiting to decide on the status of winter sports.

In the interest of time, it was decided that a separate meeting should be scheduled to vote on the MIAA Rule Change Proposals. Committee members were encouraged to review all rule change proposals in advance of the meeting.
