MIAA Ice Hockey Committee Meeting Minutes – Jan. 31, 2023

The Ice Hockey Committee met at the Franklin office on Jan. 31, 2023.

Minutes: Minutes of the previous meeting, Sept. 21, 2022, were moved and approved, (J. Rudzinsky, S. Paine) 13-0-0

Winter Season/Tournament 2023: R. Pearson and S. Paine spoke to planning for the upcoming 2023 Tournament. Semi-Final venues have been selected and will be listed ASAP. Assignment of officials, for semi-final and final games will be done by J. Doyle again this year.

Other items discussed to be mentioned to all teams/coaches include: cat-eye goalie mask, overtime procedure and pregame meetings. In preparation for the tournament, S. Paine will communicate attention to tournament items: 22 players, overtime, timeline for tournament and semi-final/final sites and planning. Possible town hall webinars could be offered.

Format 2024: R. Pearson mentioned the Format for 2024 to be discussed and approved at the April meeting. It was mentioned that the chairman and liaison met with TMC representatives on 1/26/23 to offer feedback on winter sports. Other items to consider for Format 2024 are cutoff date (2/22/24) and possibility of playing on Sunday when ice may be easy to acquire.

Scoresheets – Discussion: Committee members talked about a need to re-institute three ply game sheets for schools. It appeared that although not sent and printed for a few years, many schools had not needed more until they ran out this year. Many committee members talked about needing the three-ply sheet for all games.
