Student and Coach Contest Disqualification Forms

Please make sure to use the most up-to-date version of the MIAA Student and Coach Contest Disqualification Forms. These forms were updated in August 2023 and are available in the "Officials" section of the MIAA website. When a student or coach is disqualified from a contest, the required form must be completed by the game official and submitted to the athletic director in charge of the contest before leaving the site. Please note - All fields within the form are required to be completed by the game official, as well as a description of the disqualification <u>including the violation called</u>. Forms submitted with incomplete information may be returned to the host school/game official to provide any missing details.

Cooperative Team and Middle Level Waiver Applications

Middle Level waivers and Coop Applications cannot be applied for after the first possible date of competition for each season." The final application dates for Fall sports are:

Golf: August 23
Football: September 3
All other sports: September 1

Student Eligibility Waiver Deadlines

As a reminder, below are the seasonal deadlines for student eligibility waiver submissions as outlined in MIAA rule 87.1. These are firm deadlines and late waivers will not be accepted.

- o Fall September 22, 2024
- o Winter December 15, 2024
- o Spring April 1, 2025

Fall 2024 Schedule Commitment Deadline & Process

With practices and tryouts for Fall 2024 sports now under way, this is a reminder that the MIAA schedule commitment deadline is **Friday, September 13**.

All schedules for **Cross Country**, **Field Hockey**, **Football**, **Fall Golf**, **Soccer**, **Fall Swim & Dive**, and **Girls Volleyball** must be entered into Arbiter by the end of the day on September 13. After that point, no changes can be made to your opponents or the number of games/matches that can be played. After the September 13 commitment deadline, all schedules will be considered **FINAL**.

Three days before the Schedule Commitment deadline, MIAA staff will produce and publish schedules for each sport based on the available data for review and verification by member schools. Below is the breakdown for 2024-25 school year:

- FALL 2024
 - o First contest date: Sunday, September 1
 - Schedule data published for review: Tuesday, September 10
 - Schedule Commitment deadline: Friday, September 13
- WINTER 2024-2025
 - o First contest date: Thursday, December 12
 - Schedule data published for review: Tuesday, December 17
 - Schedule Commitment deadline: Friday, December 20
- SPRING 2025
 - o First contest date: Thursday, March 27
 - Schedule data published for review: Tuesday, April 1
 - Schedule Commitment deadline: Friday, April 4

Please be sure to check the <u>MIAA Sport Limitations</u> <u>Information Sheet</u> for the maximum number of competitions allowed per week and per season in each sport.

Neck Laceration Protectors for Ice Hockey Required 2024-25

In the spring of 2024, the NFHS Ice Hockey Rules Committee added neck laceration protectors to the required ice hockey equipment. All high school ice hockey players will now be required to wear a neck laceration protector – in its original manufactured state and as intended by the manufacturer – during all MIAA interscholastic contests, scrimmages and practices.
