## **General Information**

## 1. Rules:

MIAA and Special Olympics Massachusetts rules will be followed.

#### 2. Divisions:

- A. Team divisions and sections will be developed based upon the number of competition slots available for each team. The competition slots are determined based upon roster sizes (partners and athletes) that must be reported to MIAA and Special Olympics MA by April 12 (see page 4). Divisions 1 and 2 will be divided as evenly as possible after the competition slot data is finalized.
- B. Team scores will be calculated for both Division 1 and Division 2 at the Sectional Meets and State Championship Meets.

# 3. Qualifying Standards:

- A. At the Sectional Meets the student-athletes will be placed into pre-defined tiers within each event based on submitted performances to Athletic.net.
- B. For the State Championship Meet student-athletes will qualify based on performances from the Sectional Meets.



# 4. Exhibition Competition

Exhibition races will be conducted for students that utilize wheelchairs or assistive devices that are not self-propelled.

## 5. Medical Coverage:

A licensed athletic trainer will be available at all MIAA/Special Olympics Massachusetts meets.

## 6. Responsibility of Participating Schools:

All schools are responsible before, during and after a meet for the proper conduct of their coaches, student-athletes and spectators.

# 7. Team Sportsmanship Award:

Nominations for the MIAA/Special Olympics Massachusetts Unified Track and Field Team Sportsmanship Award are due by May 7, 2024.

# 9. Jury of Appeals:

Will be composed of three officials and two coaches.

#### 10. Free Admission:

Admission will be free for spectators at all meets.

## 11. Media:

It is anticipated that newspaper and television reporters will be present to interview coaches and studentathletes. A media area will be setup.

#### 12. Awards Ceremonies:

At both the Sectional Meets and the State Championship Meet:

- A. The individual events awards ceremonies will take place at the conclusion of each event.
- B. The team awards ceremonies will take place at the conclusion of the meet.



# **Sectional Championship Meet Information**

# A. Entry Information

- 1. Meet entries (times/distances) are due via Athletic.net on Thursday, May 2 by 11:59pm or Thursday, May 9 by 11:59pm depending upon sectional meet assignment.
- 2. Changes will not be permitted after the entry deadline scratches only.
- 3. The defined tiers within each event are listed on Page 6 and submitted performances will be placed accordingly.

# 4. Individual Entry Limitations

Participants may be entered in a maximum of 1 field event, 1 running event, and 1 relay event. Please see #6 and #7 below for additional details regarding the differences between *Athlete* and *Partner* entry limitations.

## 5. Athlete Entries

All Athletes may be entered in 1 field event, 1 running event, and 1 relay event.

## 6. Partner Entries

If a team roster includes more partners than athletes, the number of competition slots for *Partner* entries will be based upon the number of *Athletes* competing on a team multiplied by three (not to exceed a maximum of 1 field event, 1 running event and 1 relay event per *Partner*). Please see the chart below for additional guidance regarding *Partner* entries.

# 7. Relay Entries:

<u>All schools</u> may enter <u>one</u>  $4 \times 100$  Meter Relay Team and <u>one</u>  $4 \times 400$  Meter Relay Team. Relay teams must be comprised of two athletes and two partners.

#### B. Events

The order of competition will be determined by division. Division 1 schools will begin with the Field Events and Division 2 schools will begin with the Running Events.

**Field Events:** Long Jump, Shot Put, and Javelin **Running Events:** 800 Meter, 400 Meter, 100 Meter **Relay Events:** 4 x 100 Meter Relay, 4 x 400 Meter Relay

## C. Individual and Team Awards

- 1. The top six places in **each tier within each event** in Division 1 and Division 2 will score. Points will be 10-8-6-4-2-1.
- 2. Award ceremonies will take place after the completion of each flight (field events) or heat (running events) throughout the entire meet. Ribbons will be awarded for up to 6 places for each flight or heat.
- 3. Medals will be awarded to the Champion and Finalist teams in Division 1 and Division 2.



# State Championship Meet Information Thursday, May 23, 2024 (rain date May 28) Natick High School 10:00am

# A. State Championship Meet Advancement

- 1. A total of 12 students within each tier of each running event will advance to the State Meet.
- 2. A total of 8 students within each tier of each field event will advance to the State Meet.
- 3. The champions of each tier at the Sectional Meets automatically advance to the State Meet. If the tier champion's performance exceeds the tier range from the Sectional Meet, that student will be placed in the corresponding tier of their performance for the State Meet.
- 4. After sectional tier champions are placed in the State Meet, the remaining spaces within each tier of each event will be filled by the next fastest/farthest performances from the results of all Sectional Meets combined.
- 5. If a student performs better than the performance range of their entered tier during the Sectional Meet, that student will be pushed to the higher tier to determine qualification for the State Championship Meet.
  - A student's Sectional performance may bump that student into a higher performing tier for the State meet (example: from Tier 3 to Tier 4)
  - A student's Sectional performance <u>will not</u> bump the student into a lower performing tier for the State Meet. (example: if entered in Tier 6 for the Sectional meet cannot move down to Tier 5 for the State Meet. The student will remain in Tier 6 if qualified).
- 6. Division 1 and Division 2 will compete separately.
- 7. <u>All schools</u> may enter <u>one</u> 4 x 100 Meter Relay Team and <u>one</u> 4 x 400 Meter Relay Team. Relay teams must be comprised of two athletes and two partners. All entered relay teams must have participated in at least one meet during the regular season. Teams are encouraged to practice the respective relays in advance of the state championship meet.
- 8. The heats and flights for the State Championship Meet will be posted by Friday, May 17.
- 9. All scratches are requested by **Saturday, May 18 at 12:00pm**. Scratches reported will provide an opportunity for the next eligible student from the overall list of results to advance to the state meet. No new advancements will take place after **Monday, May 20 at 10:00am**.

## C. Individual and Team Awards

- 1. The top six places in **each tier within each event** in Division 1 and Division 2 will score. Points will be 10-8-6-4-2-1.
- 2. Award ceremonies will take place after the completion of each tier of each event.
- 3. Trophies and medals will be awarded to the Champion and Finalist teams in Division 1 and 2.
