** Both tournaments will be run simultaneously sharing all 6 mats. They will be split as needed.

- Please have buses drop off by the field house bus loop. Buses will enter school grounds and go around the high school following signs for Field House.
- Enter through the glass doors. There is handicapped ramp leading up to the glass doors
- **COACHES LANYARDS** - As per MIAA policy, all coaches must have their MIAA-issued lanyard to enter for free with the team. These were issued at Sectionals.
- Spectators will be allowed to enter at 3:15pm.

Weigh-Ins & Skin Checks. +2 (106 = 108 & Girls 100 = 102)

- Weigh-ins will be done in the auxiliary gym off of the field house Lined up by weight.
- The head referee and the on-site trainer will conduct the skin check prior to the weigh in.
- Any wrestler with a visible skin condition **MUST** have an official [MIAA Physician's release form](#) signed and dated stating that the condition is non-communicable.

Day 2 Weigh-Ins & Skin Checks. *Additional +1 (106 = 109 and Girls 100 = 103)*

- Weigh-ins will be done in the auxiliary gym off of the field house. Lined up by weight.
- The head referee and the on-site trainer will conduct the skin check prior to the weigh in.
- Spectators will be allowed to enter at 10:00am.

PARKING PUBLIC AND BUSES

- Buses may leave the facility and come back at the conclusion of the event OR they may park in the far in one of the lots across from Ranger Road
- Spectator parking will be available in the parking lot on bus loop (as space allows) then additionally parking is across ranger road in the multiple parking lots located there. Please park in designated parking spots only. Parking up on curbs is strictly prohibited.
- All athletes, coaches, and officials and fans will enter through the lower field house doors by the bus loop.

LOCKER ROOMS

- Wrestlers will use the two locker rooms in the Field House. They will be clearly marked when teams arrive. We will have a gender neutral area.
- There will be a locker room for the female wrestlers
- Please note locker rooms are for athletes, coaches and officials. Spectators are not allowed.
- There will be public restrooms for spectator use.

MEDICAL COVERAGE

- Athletic Trainers will be on site from skin checks until the end of the tournament.
- An AED will be the Athletic Training staff in the Field House.
- An EMT will be on site as well.

SEATING

- Spectators will be able to enter and sit in the stands within the Field House. Spectators are NOT ALLOWED on the main tourney floor. Please sit and be respectful of those around you. There will be metal barricades to separate mats from the crowd. Players, Coaches, Officials, Medical and Facility Personnel will be allowed inside the metal barricades

FORMAT

- We will be using **six mats** throughout the course of the tournament. Mixed Gender All-States & Girls All-States will be running concurrently.
- **Championship Matches:** There is no “set time” for championship matches. We are going to wrestle all the way through with minimal breaks. *3rd – 5th– 7th place All-State matches and 3rd place Girls All-State Matches will all happen simultaneously for each weight class. This will run on 4 Mats. The 1st Place All State Matches and 1st place Girls All-State Matches will be held together on 2 mats. We will not move on to the next weight class until the bouts from the prior weight class finish during placement.*

CONCESSION STAND

- There will be a large concession stand that will be open throughout the tournament. It will be located in the main field house.
