2025 MIAA Division 1 North Sectional Wrestling Tournament

Seeding/Coaches Meeting - On Campus @ SJP Wellness Center Large Multipurpose Room (building next to football stadium) Thursday, February 13th @ 6:00 PM

- Limit of two (2) coaches per team at the seeding meeting.
- Per MIAA Tournament Format, the seeding committee will seed no more than nine (9) wrestlers per weight class. All other wrestlers will have their position drawn by lotters and placed in the first open bracket.
- All results should have been pre-entered in the FloArena website. Coaches need to bring paper copies of weigh-in sheets (in case of discrepancy in a FLO report) and their dual meet record forms.

TIMELINE OVERVIEW

- 7:30 AM Team Check-in, Doors Open
- 8:00 AM Weigh ins / skin checks
- 8:30 AM General public / spectators can enter building
- 9:00 AM Wrestling begins

7:30 AM – CHECK IN

- Please have all members of the team travel together so the team can enter the building at the same time for check in. This includes wrestlers and all three (3) coaches.
- Please limit the number of extra bags / items you bring to campus to avoid additional clutter in the building.
- Check in will be located in the lobby as you enter the wellness center front doors.

8:00 AM – WEIGH INS & SKIN CHECKS

- Skin checks will be conducted with the Head Official and Head Trainer before any wrestler is permitted to weigh in. Any wrestler with a visible skin condition must present the MIAA medical release form signed by a physician.
- Weigh-ins will be conducted by the sectional representative and the coach of the host school. Weigh-ins will take place on the mats so the results can be entered directly into the meet management program.
- Weigh-ins will be conducted by weight class beginning with the 106 lb weight class.

- All wrestlers must weigh in wearing a legal uniform.
- Following weigh-ins & skin checks, a coaches meeting will take place in the large multipurpose room (same room as seeding meeting on Thursday, Feb 13th). Coaches must wear the lanyard visible throughout the building.

8:30 AM – DOORS OPEN TO PUBLIC

• All spectators should enter the building through the front doors of the wellness center and proceed straight ahead through the lobby. Staff members will be in the lobby to redeem your online tickets before you proceed down the stairs into the field house. An elevator is located at the top of the stairs if needed.

9:00 AM – WRESTLING START TIME

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

PARKING

- Teams can be dropped off at the Main Entrance of Wellness Center (no earlier than 7:30 AM).
- Buses/vans can be directed to park at The Smith School (15 Lobao Dr, Danvers, MA 01923) until it is time to pick up the teams again on campus later in the day.
- Spectators can park on campus on a first come first serve basis. Please only park in a marked parking space and only park in a handicap accessible space if you have the appropriate accessibility tag. A map of campus is below which shows where the Wellness Center is located and all available parking lots.

LOCKER ROOMS

• The large locker room will be available for only athletes to utilize. A locker room supervisor will be on site to monitor the wellness center lower level locker room area.

TICKETS

- All tickets must be purchased through GoFan and redeemed on site (There will be NO CASH option at the door).

- Official MIAA tournament passes are accepted. Fans must present pass & sign the MIAA tournament sign-in sheet
- All coaches not arriving with the team, must purchase a ticket or have an MIAA Tournament pass ready.

FIELD HOUSE LOGISTICS, FORMAT, SEATING & AWARDS

- All wrestlers, coaches & spectators should enter the building via the front Main Entrance.
- Please keep walkways clear of people and bags in case of an emergency.

- All wrestlers/spectators should watch matches from the bleachers and/or upper balcony.
- Fans may bring a personal chair to sit in the upper balcony area
- Any wrestler/spectator sitting or standing on the edge of the mat will be asked to move. Wrestlers may be disqualified if they are removed from the mat multiple times.
- Four mats will be used for the duration of the sectional event. Championship matches (1st, 3rd, 5th) will occur simultaneously for each weight class. The next weight class will not begin until all three bouts from the prior weight class have finished.
- Award presentations will occur throughout the championship matches. Wrestlers should make their way to the award area at the conclusion of their match to be presented with their awards (106lb awarded during 120lb bouts).
- Coaches, Athletic Directors and Officials should be familiar with the 2024-2025 Wrestling Format.
- There will be a table in the middle of the field house for the Athletic Trainers.

CONCESSION STAND & MERCHANDISE

- There will be a concession stand in the front lobby of the Wellness Center. All food/beverages should be consumed and remain in the lobby area, and should not be brought into the field house.
- Merchandise will not be available on site. However, it can be purchased <u>online</u> and shipped directly to the purchaser. QR Codes to apparel stores will also be available on site to scan.
