\*\* All D2 Girls must weigh-in on Friday. The girls' tournament will then wrestle down to 8 per weight class. Please note that while some weight classes and athletes may not compete on Friday, all will receive an additional 1lb allowance on Saturday.

- Please have buses drop off by the field house. Buses will enter school grounds and go around the high school following signs for Field House.
- The Lower door will be team entrance and handicapped accessible entrance only
- **COACHES LANYARDS** As per MIAA policy, all coaches must have their MIAA-issued lanyard to enter for free with the team. These were issued at Sectionals.
- Spectators will be allowed to enter at 10:15am.

#### Weigh-Ins & Skin Checks. +2lb allowance (106 = 108)

- Weigh-ins will be done in the auxiliary gym off of the field house Lined up by weight.
- All referees and the on-site trainers will conduct the skin check prior to the weigh in.
- Any wrestler with a visible skin condition MUST have an official <u>MIAA Physician's release form</u> signed and dated stating that the condition is non-communicable.

#### Wrestling format for the divisions:

- Early rounds for Mixed-Coed and Girls tournament will utilize all the mats available to optimize for rest times.
- When possible, the tournaments will be assigned to dedicated mats.

#### Day 2 Weigh-Ins & Skin Checks. Additional +1 for those who competed Friday (106 = 109)

- Weigh-ins will be done in the auxiliary gym off of the field house. Lined up by weight.
- All referees and the on-site trainers will conduct the skin check prior to the weigh in.
- Spectators will be allowed to enter at 9:00am.

## PARKING PUBLIC AND BUSES (77 Willson St, Salem, MA 01970)

- Buses may leave the facility and come back at the conclusion of the event OR they may park in the far parking lot closest to the main road.
- Spectator parking will be available in the parking lots in front of the school and behind the field house along the right side of the gym. Parking will also be available at Collins Middle School, and Bertram Field. Please park in designated parking spots only. Cars will be towed if they are not in an official parking spot.
- All athletes, coaches, and officials will enter through the lower field house doors.
- The General Public will go up the stairs outside of the field house, handicapped accessible doors will be the lower field house doors.

## LOCKER ROOMS

- Wrestlers will use the two locker rooms in the Field House. They will be clearly marked when teams arrive. We will have a gender-neutral area.
- Changing Rooms and bathrooms for female wrestlers will be available.
- Gender neutral changing rooms and bathrooms will be available.
- Please note locker rooms are for athletes, coaches and officials. Spectators are not allowed.
- There will be public restrooms for spectator use.

### MEDICAL COVERAGE

- Athletic Trainers will be on site from skin checks until the end of the tournament.
- An AED will be the Athletic Training staff in the Field House.
- An EMT will be on site as well.

### SEATING

• Spectators will be able to enter and sit in the stands within the Field House. Spectators are NOT ALLOWED on the main tourney floor. Please sit and be respectful of those around you.

### FORMAT

- We will be using **six mats** throughout the course of the tournament. Mixed Gender States & Girls States will be running concurrently.
- **Championship Matches:** There is no "set time" for championship matches. We are going to wrestle all the way through with minimal breaks.  $3^{rd} 5^{th} 7^{th}$  place State matches and  $3^{rd}$  place Girls State Matches will all happen simultaneously for each weight class. This will run on 4 Mats. The 1st Place State Matches and 1st place Girls State Matches will be held together on 2 mats. We will not move on to the next weight class until the 6 bouts from the prior weight class finish during placement.

## **CONCESSION STAND**

• There will be a concession stand that will be open throughout the tournament. They will be located on the upper level of the field house on the balcony. Tables will be located on the Balcony and in the back hallway for spectators to eat. All Food Should be consumed in the set up tables.
