FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 21

As per MIAA policy, all coaches must have their MIAA-issued lanyard to enter for free and be with their team. These were issued at Sectionals.

9:00AM - ONLY coaches and wrestlers may start to arrive at 9:00AM.

- If teams need to arrive before 9:00AM, you need to contact Joe Cusack in advance at cusackj@foxborough.k12.ma.us
- Teams will enter the Gym by using the Gym Entrance in front of the school.
- Team buses will drop the teams off, and park off-site. Buses will not be allowed to park on campus, due to a shortage of parking.
- Teams arriving in team vans can park in a regular parking space on campus.

9:30 AM - Team Check-In

10:00 AM - Weigh-in/Skin Checks will be conducted in the gym.

- 2-pound allowance (i.e. 106 is 108)
- Coaches meeting to take place following weigh-ins.
- Spectator arrival. **Spectators are not allowed in Foxboro High School prior to 10:00AM.**

11:00 AM - Round 1 starts following the National Anthem (subject to start earlier, but not prior to 10:30AM).

- Will wrestle from 1st Round through 2nd round consolations on Friday.

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 22

As per MIAA policy, all coaches must have their MIAA-issued lanyard to enter for free and be with their team. These were issued at Sectionals.

8:00 AM - ONLY coaches and wrestlers may start to arrive at 8:00AM.

- If teams need to arrive before 8:00AM, you need to contact Joe Cusack in advance at cusackj@foxborough.k12.ma.us
- Teams will enter the Gym by using the Gym Entrance in front of the school.
- Team buses will drop the teams off, and park off-site. Buses will not be allowed to park on campus, due to a shortage of parking.
- Teams arriving in team vans can park in a regular parking space on campus.

8:30 AM - Team Check-In

9:00 AM - Weigh-in/Skin Checks will be conducted in the gym.

- Mixed-Gender tournament – 3-pound allowance (i.e. 106 is 109)
- Girls' tournament – 2-pound allowance (i.e. 100 is 102)
- Coaches meeting to take place following weigh-ins.
- Spectator arrival. **Spectators are not allowed in Foxboro High School prior to 9:00 AM.**

10:00 AM - Wrestling starts following the National Anthem (subject to start earlier, but not prior to 9:30AM).

- Girls 1st rounds
- Mixed-Gender Semi-Finals/3rd round Consolation
- Divisional State Consolation Finals for Mixed Gender & Girls
- Divisional State Championship Matches for Mixed Gender & Girls (2 mats)

There is no "set time" for championship matches. We are going to wrestle all the way through with minimal breaks.

Other important information

Skin Checks/Weigh-in

- Only the host coach and sectional representative will conduct weigh-in (oversight by tournament director if present)
- All referees and the lead on-site Athletic Trainer will conduct the skin check prior to the weigh in. Any wrestler with a visible type skin condition **MUST** have an official MIAA Physician's release form signed and dated stating that the condition is non-communicable. These forms can be found in the format.

Parking – Public and Busses

- Team buses will drop the teams off, and park off-site. Buses will not be allowed to park on campus, due to a shortage of parking.
- Teams arriving in team vans can park in a regular parking space on the Foxboro HS campus.
- **Any car parked illegally will be towed at the owner's expense.** In order to maintain the safety of our student athletes, we must strictly enforce the parking regulations. The public may only park in spots which are lined for parking.

Locker Rooms

- Locker rooms are connected to the gym and will be available to competing student-athletes only.

Concession Stand

- There will be food and drinks available throughout the entire tournament on both Friday and Saturday. The main concession stand will be in the Foxboro HS cafeteria down the hall from the gym.
- **Nobody is permitted in an area of the school that is closed to the public.**

- They can be purchased at the door or in advance on the GoFan website or via their mobile app).
- Official MIAA tournament passes are accepted.
