- Please have buses drop off in loop by home football bleachers and then park in lot behind Left field of baseball field
- The doors behind home football bleachers will be the team entry point as well as all spectators.
- As per MIAA a maximum of three coaches per team will be allowed in for free and must check in with the team.
 - These coaches will receive name badges, which they must wear from Sectionals through Divisional States and All-States. The information was provided by each school's Athletic Director.
 - Spectators will be allowed to enter at 8:20am.

WEIGH IN & SKIN CHECK. +2 (106 = 108)

- Weigh-ins will be done in the Middle school gym by weight class. (located down hall from lobby you entered)
- All referees and the on-site trainers will conduct the skin check prior to the weigh in.
- Any wrestler with a visible skin condition MUST have an official MIAA Physician's release form signed and dated stating that the condition is non-communicable.

PARKING PUBLIC AND BUSES

- Buses may leave the facility and come back at the conclusion of the event OR they may park in the far parking lot behind the left field fence of the baseball stadium..
- Spectator parking will be available in the parking lots in front of the school. Please park in designated parking spots only.
- All athletes, coaches, and officials will enter through the doors behind home football bleachers.
- The General Public will enter through the same doors behind home football bleachers.

LOCKER ROOMS

- Wrestlers will use the two locker rooms under the gym. They will be clearly marked when teams arrive.
- Changing Rooms and bathrooms for female wrestlers will be available.
- Please note locker rooms are for athletes, coaches and officials. Spectators are not allowed.
- There will be public restrooms for spectator use.

TICKETING THROUGH GOFAN

- General Admission: \$11.50 per day set by the MIAA
- Tickets can be purchased online here: https://gofan.co/app/school/MIAA OR through a QR at the venue
- Only Official MIAA tournament passes are accepted and those in possession of them must sign in at the ticketing table.

MEDICAL COVERAGE

- Athletic Trainers will be on site from skin checks until the end of the tournament.
- An AED will be with the Athletic Training staff at all times and there are multiple AED's near the gym.

SEATING

- Spectators will be able to enter and sit in the stands within the gym. Spectators are NOT ALLOWED on the main tourney floor. Please sit and be respectful of those around you.
- Stanchions will surround the mats and should not be crossed unless you are an athlete, coach, trainer, or tournament personnel.

FORMAT

- We will be using **4 mats** throughout the course of the tournament.
- **Championship Matches:** There is no "set time" for championship matches. We are going to wrestle all the way through with minimal breaks.

CONCESSION STAND

• There will be 1 concession stand that will be open throughout the tournament. It will be located in the school cafeteria up the hall from the main gym. All Food Should be consumed in the set up tables.
