7:30 AM Team Check In

As per MIAA a maximum of three coaches per team will be allowed in for free and must check in with the team.

Coaches Lanyards will be distributed at Sectionals and must be kept by the coaches through the duration of the Massachusetts tournaments

(Breakfast/ Lunch/Dinner (food & drinks) will be available all day!)

8:00 AM Weigh-Ins & Skin Checks.

8:30 AM Coaches Meeting

9:00 AM Doors open to the public. Fans can enter the gym area.

9:30 AM Earliest Possible START TIME 10:00 AM Latest Anticipated START TIME

There will be no breaks / minimal breaks throughout the tournament.

Championship Matches ($1^{st} - 3^{rd} - 5^{th}$ place matches): There is no "set time" for championship matches. We are going to wrestle all the way through with minimal breaks. Based on the size of the tournament, we are anticipating that the championship matches will begin at some time near 3:00 PM. However, they may start earlier or later, depending on how fast the tournament moves along.

Skin Checks/Weigh-in

8:00 am

- Only the host coach and sectional representative will conduct weigh-in (oversight by tournament director if present)
- The head referee and the on-site trainer will conduct the skin check prior to the weigh
 in. Any wrestler with a visible type skin condition MUST have an official MIAA Physician's
 release form signed and dated stating that the condition is non-communicable. These forms
 can be found in the format.

TEAM SEATING

The first 3 or 4 rows will be reserved for competitors. SPECTATOR SEATING WILL BEGIN IN ROW 5

Note: Barricades will be set up around mats. We ask that coaches help prevent athletes from gathering around and blocking walkways.

Parking - Public and Busses

- Please use the BUS LANE for drop offs. Buses may leave the facility and come back at the conclusion of the event OR they may park in the far parking lot with the gazebo.
- Spectator parking is at one of our three parking lots. Parking lot 2 (in front of the gym) will fill
 up by 9:30 so please use lots 1 and 3. The public is reminded to obey all parking signs and
 note that <u>Any car parked illegally will be towed at the owner's expense.</u> In order to
 maintain the safety of our student athletes, we must strictly enforce the parking
 regulations. The public may only park in spots which are lined for parking.

Locker Rooms

Female wrestlers should use the ladies team locker room, which is the last Locker room in the gym on the side of the AMERICAN FLAG. Male wrestlers will use the two other locker rooms off the gym. We will conduct weigh in in the back of the gym behind the curtain.

Concession Stand

The concession stand will be open throughout the tournament in the cafeteria. All food should be consumed in the café.

T-Shirt/Sweatshirt ordering forms will be displayed so fans may purchase gear on line.
