SECTIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS: 1st - 3rd – 5th place matches will be held simultaneously. The next weight class will not start until all 3 bouts are finished.	To start approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of the previous round.	
Sectional Championship matches will have assistant referees.	Wrestling is subject to starting earlier.	

- Please have buses drop off teams at the main entrance of Gloucester High School
- As per MIAA a maximum of three coaches per team will be allowed in for free and must check in with the team.
 - o These coaches will receive name badges, which they must wear from Sectionals through Divisional States and All-States. The information was provided by each school's Athletic Director.
- Spectators will be allowed to enter at 8am.

WEIGH IN & SKIN CHECK. +2 (106 = 108)

- Weigh-ins will be done in the GHS weight room by weight class.
- All referees and the on-site trainer will conduct the skin check prior to the weigh in, in the GHS weight room
- Any wrestler with a visible skin condition MUST have an official MIAA Physician's release form signed and dated stating that the condition is non-communicable.

PARKING PUBLIC AND BUSES

- Buses may leave the facility and come back at the conclusion of the event OR they may park on the opposite side
 of school from the main entrance (near tennis courts). Along the water that has longer parking spaces designed
 for boat trailers.
- Spectator parking will be available in the parking lots in front of the school and side of school by stadium. Please park in designated parking spots only.
- All athletes, coaches, and officials will enter through the main entrance
- The General Public will enter through the main entrance

LOCKER ROOMS

- Wrestlers will use the two locker rooms on the 2nd floor balcony. They will be clearly marked when teams arrive.
- Changing Rooms and bathrooms for female wrestlers will be available.
- Gender neutral changing rooms and bathrooms will be available.
- Please note locker rooms are for athletes, coaches and officials. Spectators are not allowed.
- There will be public restrooms for spectator use on the first floor

TICKETING THROUGH GOFAN

- General Admission: \$11.50 per day set by the MIAA
- Tickets can be purchased online here: https://gofan.co/app/school/MIAA OR through a QR at the venue
- Only Official MIAA tournament passes are accepted and those in possession of them must sign in at the ticketing table.

MEDICAL COVERAGE

- Athletic Trainers will be on site from skin checks until the end of the tournament.
- An AED will be with the Athletic Training staff in the Field House.

SEATING

Spectators will be able to enter and sit in the stands within the fieldhouse, and all 2nd floor balconies.
 Spectators are NOT ALLOWED on the main tourney floor. Please sit and be respectful of those around you.

FORMAT

- We will be using **4 mats** throughout the course of the tournament.
- Championship Matches: There is no "set time" for championship matches. We are going to wrestle all the way
 through with minimal breaks.

CONCESSION STAND

 There will be 1 concession stand that will be open throughout the tournament. It will be located on the 2nd floor balcony overlooking all the mats. All Food Should be consumed on the 2nd floor balcony. No Food allowed in the Fieldhouse
