- Participate in Ambassador Service Challenges
- Work with fellow ambassadors in your school, district and across the state to develop action plans for future community service ideas
- Contribute to the MIAA “Building the Future” Educational Athletics Newsletter
- Serve as a liaison in your school with the student body, Principal and Athletic Director
- Participate in additional student leadership opportunities

Goals/Expectations

- Student Ambassadors will assume leadership roles in their schools and communities
