MIAA Field Hockey Committee Meeting Highlights – September 22, 2021

There were 20 people in attendance at this virtual meeting including coaches, ADs, Tournament Directors, and MIAA staff.

Welcome:

After attendance was taken, members were reminded to complete and submit the Conflict of Interest Form that was emailed with the agenda.

Election of Officers:

TMC Updates: Sherry Bryant, Liaison highlighted the game officials section of the format indicating that language will be added once TMC vets recommendation due from Game Officials Committee. This language will speak in more detail to assignment of officials for tournament play. Sherry highlighted the recently emailed and posted [Statewide Tournament FAQ document](#) and [Power Rating Information](#) document.

Boys Field Hockey: The committee was made aware that no boys field hockey teams were registered by member schools for Fall 2021. Committee members were asked to gather information from colleagues as to the interest of membership and potential obstacles we may look to address. The committee will include this discussion on the December meeting agenda. Sherry and Katherine Hennessy each spoke to committee members about the willingness of USA FH to assist us in moving this sport forward.

Field Hockey Ed Camp: Mary Ryan, John O'Neil and Sherry Bryant each spoke to the Summer FH Ed Camp offering. There were over 60 coaches that participated in this offering. The topics selected by participants included rules review, officiating discussion, drills and best practices. The committee will sponsor a post season coaches gathering following the Fall 2021 season.

Discriminatory Incident Reporting Initiative: The committee was made aware of the Discriminatory Incident Reporting initiative from the DEI Committee. More information on this item will be forwarded to the membership once approved by the MIAA Board of Directors.

Title IX at 50 Campaign: The NFHS will be promoting a Title IX at 50 campaign throughout the 2021-22 school year. The campaign will include highlighting of Title IX trailblazers and moments of magnitude. The NFHS will be highlighting Massachusetts during the month of October.
