MIAA Wrestling Committee Highlights February 25, 2021

The MIAA Wrestling Committee held their scheduled meeting on Thursday, February 25, 2021. The following information is an effort to keep you updated on the meeting.

- Committee was informed that the **EEA will be analyzing** the first few weeks of the football season before considering a move of wrestling from level 2 to level 3, which would allow interscholastic competitions.
- **Proposed wrestling modifications** were reviewed at length and ultimately approved 16-0 (*Motion by Dr. Robert Pritchett, second by Jeff Lareau*)
- **Next steps** – If the EEA moves wrestling to level 3, Brendan Kent (Chair), Ann Palumbo (Vice chair) and Phil Napolitano (Liaison) will present the modifications to the MIAA Sports Medicine Committee. If supported by SMC, the modifications will then get to the MIAA COVID-19 Task Force and ultimately the MIAA Board of Directors for final approval.
- **A sub-committee** is being formed to review the current MIAA wrestling tournament structure (sectionals, states, and all-states). Their task is to come up with different models to consider if wrestling changed their tournament structure in the future.
- The committee was informed that **FLOARENA** recently purchased Track Wrestling.
- Upcoming educational athletics initiatives were promoted
