- **WARNING: Traffic pattern change!!**
 - Mass Ave North (from Mass Ave Bridge/Boston) **Left Turn** on to Vassar Street is **no longer possible**. Best access to parking is using Memorial Drive West and turn Right on to Vassar Street.
 - **NOTE:** Cambridge often updates traffic patterns, parking availability and restrictions. MIT has several construction projects which has changed the campus in the past two years.
- Please follow any local or state traffic laws when parking on campus. Any vehicle not parked in a designated spot or in a fire lane is subject to be ticketed or towed at the owner's expense.

- Bus drop off should be on **Amherst Street** with parking at the **Waverly Lot**.
