



Mansfield High School Student Receives MIAA Student-Athlete of the Month Award March 2023

As a student, Drew's current weighted GPA is 4.474 and he has been the recipient of Yale Book Award for Character and Intellectual Promise, the Golden Hornet Award (9, 10, 11) for all subject grades over 90 for all 4 terms of the year, the Tom Souza Scholar-Athlete Award for Football, Nominated for National Football Foundation Scholar-Athlete Award, and the World Language Academic Excellence Award (Spanish). Nominated by Assistant Athletic Director and Football Coach Mike Redding, Drew is also a member of the National Honor Society and Spanish Honor Society.

As an athlete, Drew has been a 4-yr member of the Football Program and 3-yr Varsity Starter at Running Back, named Player of the Week for games against Stoughton and Foxboro in the 2022 season. A 4-yr starter of the Lacrosse Program, he was an All-Star as a Junior, Elected Team Captain as a senior, Sun Chronicle All-Star as a junior.
